Today, I am happy to share with you the <u>COVID-19 Family Handbook</u> that outlines new policies, procedures and protocols that we will put into place for the health and safety of our children, staff and families.

This handbook represents the work of our Reopening Task Force and the guidance of many organizations that include the Centers for DIsease Control and Prevention (CDC), the Office of Child Development and Early Learning (OCDEL), the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC), and the City and State Departments of Health.

It is an expectation that each family will read the Handbook carefully and work closely with us in complying with all the information outlined. While we attempted to cover as many things as possible, we expect that there will continue to be many questions.
